To make 1 litre of milk, add 250g of powder to 400ml of pre-boiled warm water, mix till dispersed, then make up to 1 litre with warm water.

Say your joey is 1250g and you want to make enough milk to last the day. Then taking into account that you might spill some, you need to make up 100ml.

To make up 100ml measure out 25g of milk powder and add about half the water (50ml), mix till dispersed and then top up with the extra water to make the total 100ml.

The Milk can be made up and frozen, for up to 2 weeks, in usable size portions.

Remember not to heat or defrost the milk in the microwave, this changes the molecular structure of the milk, which is harmful to your Joey.
